**Parking**: Off of Route 85 (Hudson Road); gravel drive and parking area located off of route 85 at trail head.

**Weather Policy**: We will plan to hold the event if sustained rain is light. The rain date option will be used if sustained rain is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Join Bolton's Conservation Administrator and Volunteer Land Steward, on a two-hour ramble through the newly established <u>Keyes Farm Open Space</u>, to explore the Conservation Area and trail. The new trail was initiated by our Planning Board's requirement of a FOSPRD style development members!

The trail extends along the western side of the Keyes Farm Development through one of its associated open space parcels. The property is host to what is considered to be one of the oldest homes in town. You will see remnants of past logging throughout the trail. We may also encounter deer, turkey, and other wildlife!

**Recommended Gear**: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water. Dogs are welcome if under direct control of owner; ON LEASH for the walk please. No umbrellas please.
