

Take a Walk on the Wild Side

At Taggart Forestland

Event Date: Thursday, October 21st 2021

Time: 9:00am – 11:00am

Duration: ~2 hours



Parking: Parking Area by Gravel Pit along Forbush Mill Road, Forbush Mill Field or along shoulder of roadway. **Please do not obstruct roadway.**

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained rain is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained rain is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water, wear long pants, rain gear if applicable, bug repellent and closed toed shoes.

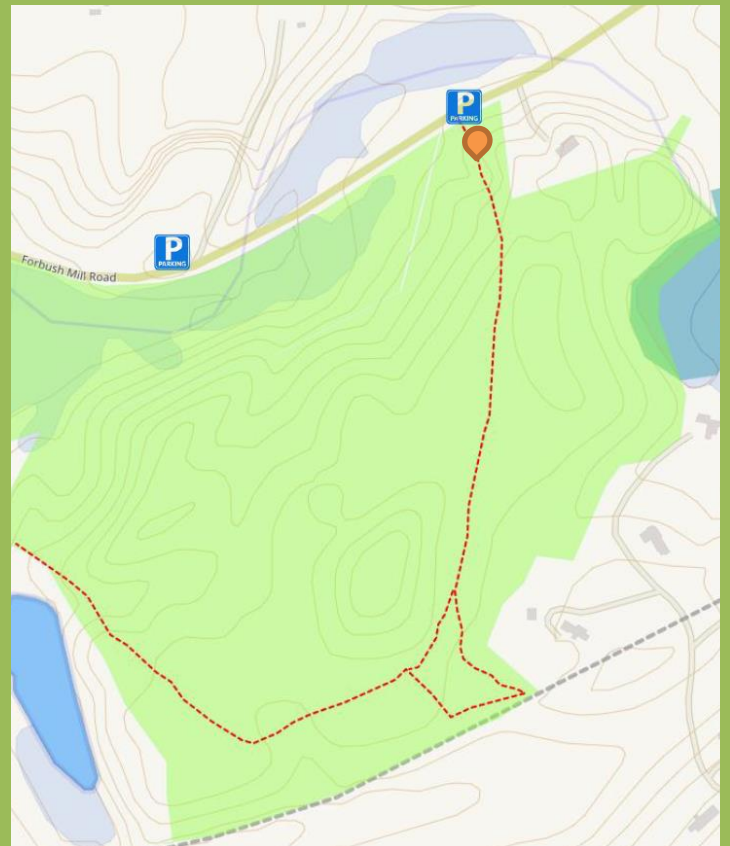
Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

Wildlife sightings may include turkey, deer, red tail hawks, beaver among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!
