

Take a Walk on the Wild Side

At Danforth Conservation Area

Event Date: Tuesday, November 23rd 2021

Time: 3:00pm – 5pm

Duration: ~2 hours



Parking: Parking Area along Danforth Lane (off of Route 85/Hudson Road). Please do not obstruct roadway.

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained rain is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained rain is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water, wear long pants, rain gear if applicable, bug repellent and closed toed shoes.

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

Pet Policy: Must be leashed.

End November on the right foot by joining Bolton's Conservation Agent for a walk through our Danforth Conservation Area!

The walk will begin at the trail head located off of Danforth Lane. This will be a loop trail through the property over the water body, to the utility line and ending back at Danforth Lane. Terrain is moderate to challenging due to traversing areas with ledge outcrops, wetlands, and some steep grades.

Wildlife sightings may include beaver, amphibians, and deer among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!
