

Take a Walk on the Wild Side at Houghton Farm

Event Date: February 23rd 2022

Time: 12pm

Duration: ~1.5 hours



Parking: Limited parking at Houghton Farm Lane. Please DO NOT obstruct roadway.

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained precipitation is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained precipitation is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to dress warm in layers, bring water, and appropriate footwear (areas of trail may be muddy).

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

Pet Policy: Must be leashed.

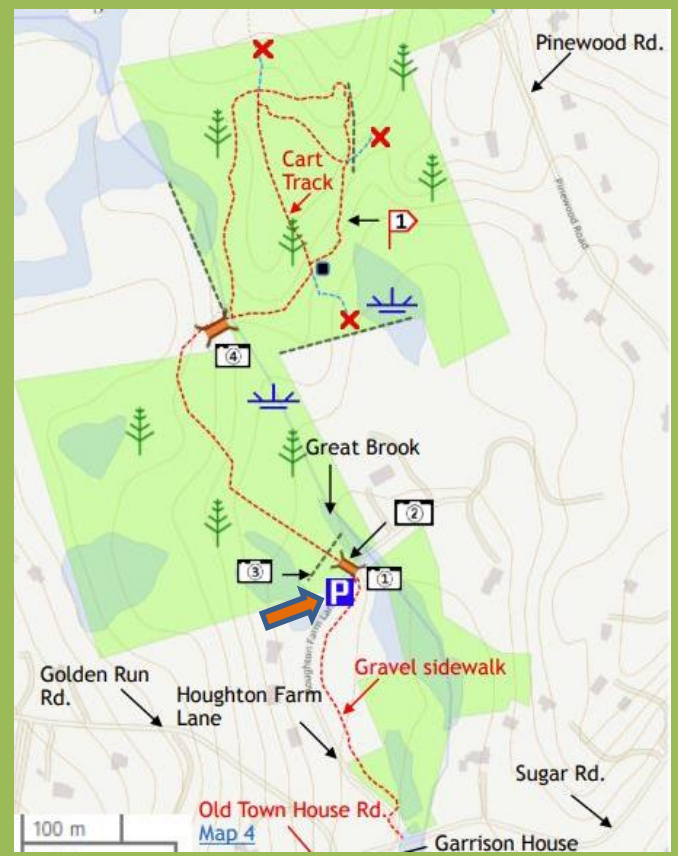

Join Bolton's Conservation Agent for a walk through Houghton Farm Conservation Area!

The walk will begin at the trail head located off of Houghton Farm Lane (see map). This will be a loop trail. Terrain is moderate to challenging due to traversing areas with ledge outcrops, and potentially wet sections. Wildlife sightings may include deer, various bird species, among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!

We encourage you to bring your binoculars, cameras, questions or just enjoy getting outdoors!
