

Take a Walk on the Wild Side

Zink Northwoods Conservation Area

Event Date: Tuesday, March 22nd 2022

Time: 12:00pm

Duration: ~2 hours



Parking: Parking Area off of Ledgewood Circle at trail head. Please DO NOT obstruct roadway or private drives.

Weather Policy: These areas are heavily canopied. We will plan to hold the event if sustained precipitation is light. The event will be cancelled if sustained precipitation is moderate to heavy, or in the event of thunder, lightning, and/or strong wind.

Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to dress in layers, bring water, and appropriate footwear (areas of trail may be muddy).

Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

Pet Policy: Must be leashed.

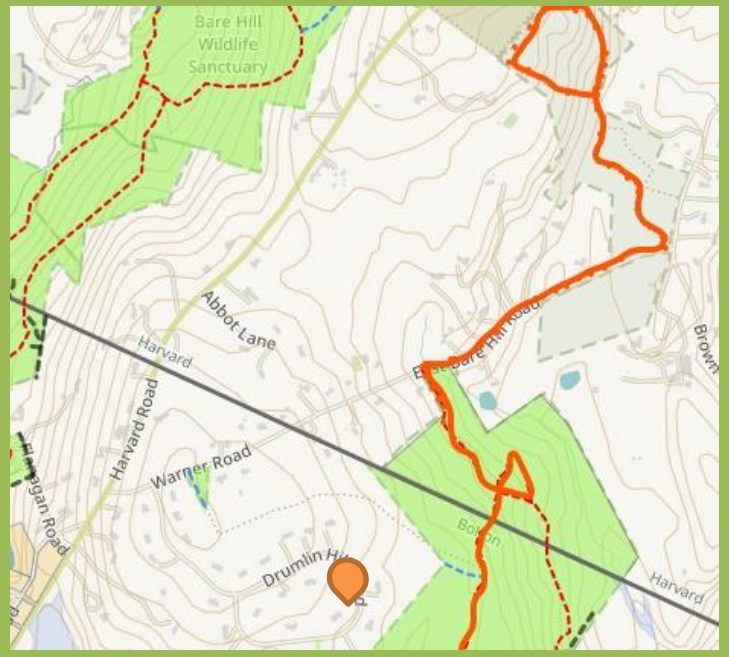

Celebrate World Water Day by joining Bolton's Conservation Agent for a walk through our Zink Northwoods Conservation Area!

The walk will begin at Ledgewood Circle (see point on map). This will be a loop walk through Zink Northwoods in Bolton, then a short walk along the roadway to Powell-Reed-Abbot in Harvard. Terrain is moderate to challenging due to traversing areas with ledge outcrops, and includes wet sections.

Wildlife sightings may include deer, various bird species, among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!
