Recommended Gear: Participants should dress appropriately. We encourage participants to bring water, and appropriate footwear. Trekking poles may be helpful.


Partner Organizations: Bolton Trails Committee, Bolton Conservation Trust and Bolton Conservation Department.

The trail guide will have discretion on the choice of route, depending on preferences of those present.

Wildlife sightings may include deer, various bird species, amphibians, among other wildlife that call this great habitat home!
