# Welch Pond Trail to Sawyer Road Gordon and Drew

- This project is approved by ConCom some time ago. There was no response from John Mortimer on the Eagle Scout project, so Gordon brought up that perhaps we should consider getting started on this.
- The route is now tagged by Gordon and approved by Ken Nicewicz. Mostly, this
  needs brush and sapling clearance, plus some trail leveling with a mattock. Updated
  trailhead maps and a post will be required. Ken Nicewicz is pleased at the possibility
  of this being done. It would be good to have this done in time for the upcoming Trail
  Guide update.
- We need 2-3 volunteers. Chris, Gordon and Larry are planning to get started on this project. Drew will help if the time permits.

# **Derby Field**
